Domaine des Remizières, Hermitage, Cuvée Emilie, 2017 : (93-94) pts.

Dark purple. Vibrant, mineral-accented dark berry and floral pastille aromas show outstanding clarity and pick up exotic spice and savory herb elements with air. Juicy and incisive on the palate, offering intense cherry, cassis, vanilla and spicecake flavors that are given spine and tension by an undercurrent of juicy acidity. Finishes supple, smoky and extremely long, displaying resonating minerality and slow-mounting tannins.

Domaine des Remizières, Crozes-Hermitage Autrement, 2017 : (93-94) pts.

Bright purple. Displays expansive aromas of fresh blueberry, blackberry, incense and candied flowers. A subtle vanilla nuance builds with air. Juicy, seamless and deeply concentrated, offering smoke-tinged dark fruit preserve, violet, olive paste, licorice and spicecake notes that build on the back half. In a powerful, yet graceful style, with sneaky tannins framing energetic dark fruit on an impressively long, floral-tinged finish.

Domaine des Remizières, Crozes-Hermitage, Cuvée Christophe: (92-93) pts.

Inky ruby. Youthfully primary, oak-spiced black/blue fruits on the highly perfumed nose. Broad and fleshy in the mouth, offering plush blueberry, cherry liqueur, floral pastille flavors and a sweet touch of vanilla. Round, velvety tannins build steadily on a long, smoke-tinged finish that leaves jammy dark fruit and salty olive notes behind.-- Josh Raynolds
